Originally from Spanish Basque Country, Deabru Beltzak is born in 1996, from the meeting between actors from different professional groups sharing the same passion for street shows. Now specialized in the design of ambulatory show, this company with international reputation, experimenting a new use of streets.



Throughout the travel, the illusion of ancestral rite is cleverly maintained by the team. Every musician exists by himself, exudes a personality of its own while belonging body and soul, to a unique and coherent whole, like an organism vibrating with one and the same pulsation. The musical scores are precise and striking, the millimeter choreography and the use of pyrotechnics reveals a perfect mastery of the crowd and the urban route. The spectator lets himself be trapped, fascinated by the light and the tribal trance unfolding before his eyes.

Aker, the devil of the Akelarre, wanders the streets. He and his suite of percussionists roam villages and towns ...

The rhythm of percussion and artifices rebound on these walls. The sparks of multicolored sparks and the sounds of instruments orchestrated to the millimeter, give rise to beautiful images. Drums respond to fire, such as pagan rituals from ancient times.

The drums vibrate, the streets are illuminated and the devil passes ...

This show mixes with finesse, music, pyrotechnics and special effects, all along an urban route. The primitive fire and the evil rhythms lead

the public in a party of the body, a trance to the origins of the man.

Technical Rider

- Duration : 50 min – approximate distance supported 800 mètres.
- Possible adaptation : contact us
- Rig before a set : 3h

- All the authorisations to perform in the streets will be ask by the organiser

- The parade journey will be cleared as much as possible (no vehicles, no obstacle, no inflammable goods...)

- The organiser will provide the team necessary to cover the journey and assure security all along the route
-
- The company need one person assistance (technical profile) during the preparation and performance

- Secure dressing-room for 7 people, minimum 20m², with mirrors, seats, tables...

- Snacks provided before and after the performances (hot drinks, cold drinks, fruits, cereals, chocolate...)

- Provide secure parking for the vehicle of the company (truck), close to the lodges...

- Full accommodation for 7 persons (** hotel, 3 twins and 1 single)
